

Bowls at the Weston Creek Labor Club

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q.** What facilities does the club have to offer for people interested in playing lawn bowls?
A. We have several options for lawn bowls available on three international size bowling greens. We have two lawn greens and a synthetic (outdoor carpet) surface - the only synthetic bowling green in the ACT.
- Q.** When are the greens available to play on?
A. The greens are available all year round and are open to the public for casual social play and corporate events 7 days a week.
- Q.** How much does it cost to play barefoot bowls?
A. The cost per player for barefoot bowls is \$15 and includes up to two hours play.
- Q.** Is there a minimum number of participants required to make a booking for barefoot bowls only?
A. No, there is no minimum number of participants.
- Q.** Do you provide the bowls?
A. Yes, we provide all bowls and equipment for all bowling experiences.
- Q.** How many participants are required to book for combined bowls activities (including barefoot bowls, bullseye bowls and/or ten pin bowls)?
A. We require a minimum booking of 20 people for combined activities.
- Q.** What is the cost for combined bowls activities?
B. The cost is \$20 per person – caters for everybody and is great value for money.
- Q.** How late can we play?
A. Bowls can be played at night under lights until 10.00pm.
- Q.** Can we just turn up or do we need to book?
A. It is necessary to book in advance - preferably with a few days notice, especially around Christmas time and during school holidays.
- Q.** What are the footwear requirements?
A. Although we encourage people to enjoy the experience of barefoot bowls during spring and summer, in the cooler months flat-soled shoes without heels or heavy grip are fine.
- Q.** Do you provide tuition?
A. Our dedicated lawn bowls coordinator will set you up, provide you with information about the basics of the game, check in to see how you are all going and also answer any questions you may have during your bowling experience.
